The College of Health Professions (CHP), McAuley School of Nursing (MSON) is using www.Castlebranch.com to provide student criminal background checks and urine drug screens. This service allows you to purchase your tests on line.

The cost is a flat rate of \$96.00 for criminal background check and urine drug screen. You will need to use a credit card, debit card or money order. Using an electronic check or money order will delay results.

- To place your order proceed to <https://portal.castlebranch.com/NR61> and follow instructions on How to Place Order. Once on the order page, select your program and proceed.

Additional Instructions for students who reside in Canada:

Follow same instructions as above. Use the Canadian resident instructions listed under your program choice. When you are asked to provide a social security number, enter all 0's.

2. Drug Screening Test:

- *Read Drug Screening Policy and Procedure.
- Castle Branch Drug Testing Services in partnership with Lab Corp will be providing Drug Testing Services for the CHP/MSON.
- **Do not over hydrate before the exam as a dilute specimen will require retesting and another fee.**
